The Grant Township board meeting was called to order at 6:03pm by Supervisor Archambo.

Board members present: Supervisor Gil Archambo, Clerk Toinelle Brasseur, Treasurer Rachel Vallance, Trustee Elyn Kallio and Trustee Eric Boyd. 3 general public members were in attendance.

Clerks Report: Update on November 3<sup>rd</sup> elections, Sent 279 AV ballots, Received 114 back as of today, 1 overseas AV ballot sent and returned, and 3 military AV ballots sent with 2 returned.

Treasurer's report: Municipal Money Market cash on hand as of 8/31/2020 was: \$81,657.17. September deposits were: \$12,800.57 and with a transfer to Checking of \$10,009.00; with a balance on hand as of 9/30/2020 of \$84,448.74.

General Fund Checking cash on hand as of 8/31/2020 was \$.56. September interest was \$.25. September deposits were \$10,009.25. September disbursements were \$10,009.44, for a balance on hand as of 9/30/2020 of \$0.37.

Municipal Money Market worth as of 9/30/2020 was \$84,448.74. General Fund Checking worth was \$0.37, and Investments on Deposit as of 09/30/2020 was \$16,7337.08 for a total net worth of \$251,786.19, which is \$20,438.61 more than the total worth this month last year.

Supervisor Archambo states the trees are put there as a guidance for people crossing the lake, to prevent them from going towards the river that does not freeze completely. He is part of placing the

trees and will be having a meeting with the group that does this to see if it would be possible to move the tree line
