

**Grant Township Monthly Board Meeting**

July 14, 2020

The Grant Township board meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Supervisor Archambo.

Board members present: Supervisor Gil Archambo, Clerk Toinelle Brasseur, Treasurer Rachel Vallance, Trustee Elyn Kallio and Trustee Eric Boyd. 7 general public members were in attendance.

The pledge was recited by all.

Addition to agenda:

Motion to accept the agenda with additions: by Treasurer Vallance and supported by Trustee Boyd. All approved, motion carried.

Motion for the approval of minutes from the June 9th, 2020 meeting by Trustee Boyd and supported by Treasurer Vallance. All approved, motion carried.

- Clerk's report: Absentee applications and ballots 172 sent, approximately 20 to still send, 28 ballots returned, and 3 MOVE (Military ballots sent)

Treasurer's report: Municipal Money Market cash on hand as of 5/31/2020 was: \$126,997.61. June deposits were: \$4520.32 and with a transfer to Checking of \$25,338.00; with a balance on hand as of 6/30/2020 of \$106,179.93.

General Fund Checking cash on hand as of 6/30/2020 was \$1.22. June interest was \$0.47. June deposits were \$25,338.47. June disbursements were \$25,338.71, for a balance on hand as of 6/30/2020 of \$0.98.

Municipal Money Market worth as of 6/30/2020 was \$106,179.93. General Fund Checking worth was \$0.98, and Investments on Deposit as of 06/30/2020 was \$166,822.56 for a total net worth of \$273,003.47, which is \$8881.16 more than the total worth this month last year.

Motion to approve the Treasurers report: by Trustee Boyd, supported by Trustee Kallio All approved, motion carried.

Public Comment: D. Heythaler wondering why the county put the barricade up in Alverno, it appears no one can come through to the open business. L. Daniel states this should be moved down to Twin Lakes Rd. Many people are using the driveway at Rippling Rapids to turn around. Gil stated he would go to the road commission and try to meet with Brent and Travis regarding barricades for roads. R. Meater spoke regarding the cellphone service in the area and encouraged the board and public to reach out to

Senator Bergman to push for cellular service in the area, questioning why the tower could not be put on property. Four deaths are related to unreliable cellular service. Per L. Daniels T Mobil is putting 5 towers in the area, none in the immediate area.
