The Grant Township board meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by Supervisor Archambo.

Treasurer's report: General IMMA cash on hand as of 6/30/2021 was: \$106,106.93. July deposits were: \$13,789.89 and with a transfer to Checking of \$35,972.00; with a balance on hand as of 7/31/2021 of \$83,978.82.

General Fund Checking cash on hand as of 6/30/2021 was \$0.77. July interest was \$0.84. July deposits were \$35,972.00. July disbursements were \$35,341.91 for a balance on hand as of 7/31/2021 of \$631.70.

Municipal Money Market worth as of 7/31/2021 was \$83,978.82. General Fund Checking worth was \$631.70, and Investments on Deposit as of 7/31/2021 was \$168,105.99 for a total net worth of \$252,716.51, which is \$4792.19 more than the total worth this month last year.

Old Business: Blight ordinance, reviewed at the MTA meeting on July 21st and July 29th, the ordinance was to be updated and reviewed again at the August 24th MTA meeting for final draft.

Public Comment: Residents in the audience pleaded with board regarding the blight ordinance, giving examples of how items may not be blight, however feels the way the ordinance is written would be an issue and asked the board to write as common sense.

Meeting Reports: Supervisor Archambo reported on the road commission meeting and plans for South River Rd. Trustee Boyd reported on the Oak Hill Cemetery, MTA meeting regarding ordinance for blight.
